Then, communicate your ideas through animation.

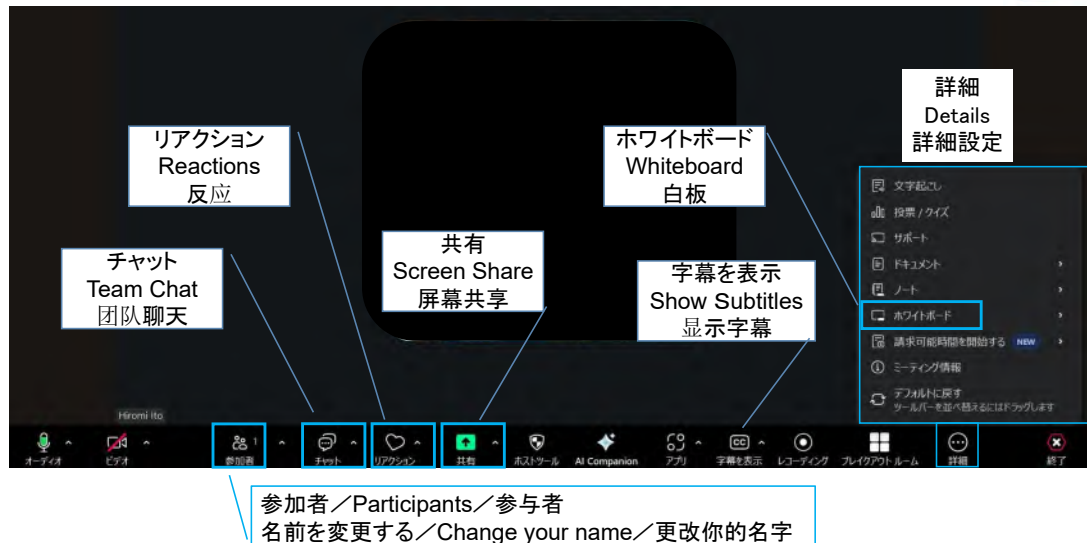
● Speak and visualize your ideas.

- Work in groups.
- Use translation apps and digital tools.
- Use more and more illustrations, videos, onomatopoeic manga symbols, and emoticons (顔文字 kaomoji).
- Translate from Bahasa Malaysia, English into Japanese.

● We use “Slack” for group-work and communication.



Zoom's Functions



6 intensive work days + group-work + individual work 5PM~(4PM in Malaysia)/2.5 hours per intensive day



* Before class begins: Create a **One-Pager** and **Self-introduction Video**.

Nov 30, D1: **One-Pager** and **Video presentation**, group discussion, lecture.

Dec 21, D2: Group discussion (What you consider important), lecture.

Dec 28, D3: **Midterm presentation** (Important issues), group discussion, lecture.

Jan 4, D4: Group discussion (Message you want to convey in animation),

Midterm presentation (Preliminary plan of your animation).

Jan 11, D5: Group work (Making an animation).

Extra work: Making an animation, preparing for the presentation,
and how you will spread your message and animation.

Jan 18, D6: Presentation, group discussion (Improve and spread your animation).

* **Between work days, you will work in groups or individually.**

Additional Activities for Further Achievement Voluntary participation

What you complete and submit



(1) Group work results

- **Group discussions memorandum**
 - **Idea Notebook worksheet**
 - Scene plan, Character designs
 - **Storyboard**
 - Presentation materials: slides, supplementary materials, etc.
- Think about how you will present and communicate your animated message, and then put your plan into action!

What you complete and submit



(2) Animation

- Short animation (3 minutes or less)
- Various expressions, including Japanese language, movement/facial expressions, onomatopoeia, and manga symbols
- Theme: “Water” of various perspectives
- Presentation slides showing the overall message (supplementary materials for the animation)

★Don't animate everything★

Only animate the key parts of your message!

(3) One-Pager and Self-introduction Video

You, group members and college-student leaders learn and teach each other!



● Learning together

- You all work together with college-student leaders in groups.
- You share your knowledge with the group members.

● Instructors

- Don't just teach, encourage awareness or give advice to you.
- Provide feedback on your midterm and 1.18 presentations.

● Administrative office (Hitosan, Nami-san)

- Make it easy for everyone to work together = Tell us what you're struggling with.
